Family Follow-up

This week's lesson is called "The Fiery Furnace." The story is found in *Daniel 3*.

This week's memory verse is: When you pass through deep waters, I will be with you; your troubles will not overwhelm you. When you pass through fire, you will not be burned; the hard trials that come will not hurt you. *Isaiah 43:2* 

Here are some questions to help you review today's story with your child:

- 1. Who were Daniel's friends? (Daniel's friends were Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.)
- 2. What did King Nebuchadnezzar tell them to do? (The king told them to worship the gold statue.)
- 3. What did Daniel's friends say? (Our God is able to save us, but even if He does not, we will not worship your idol.)
- 4. What happened next? (God was with Daniel's friends in the fire and they were not burned.)
